Grayson,

GAI would like to request an extension for time only to Work Authorization CM2452-WA08, Water Treatment Plant Emergency Standby Generator Replacement. It took much longer than expected to hear from the vendors and their cooperative contract purchasing options as well as their ability to meet the draft specifications. We will also need to account for the time necessary to order, receive and install the generator and associated foundation and equipment. We estimate that once ordered, the generator may take up to 16-weeks to arrive onsite and up to an additional 45-days to complete the installation and the project close-out process. Therefore, GAI respectfully requests an extension of 157 days.

Please note that the above timeframes are estimates only and are based on current industry standards. The delivery timeframe may change depending upon the of the features ultimately selected by NAU and FGUA.
