A. SUMMARY OF SERVICES TO BE RENDERED

This work authorization addresses the construction bidding services for the Nassau Amelia Utility (NAU) Booster Pump Station. The project includes assisting FGUA with the solicitation of formal bids for the reconstruction and rehabilitation of the NAU Booster Pump Station.

Project Background

NAU provides water and wastewater services to customers via its water utility system, which consists of a service area throughout the Amelia Island area. As part of its Rehabilitation and Replacement (R&R) program, NAU continues to improve its system.

For this project, NAU desires to rehabilitate/replace the Booster Pump Station (BPS). The BPS building foundation has been continuously experiencing settlement and the ground storage tank has leaks. In May 2015, Nassau Amelia Utilities (NAU) authorized GAI to conduct a structural investigation of the Amelia Island BPS. GAI recommended the rehabilitation or replacement of the facility. Consequently, in December 2016, GAI was tasked with developing a hydraulic model for NAU's transmission water mains as a tool to project necessary upgrades to maintain and accommodate the future growth. Based on the hydraulic modeling analysis, a BPS upgrade has been designed with properly sized pumps, which will meet the required fire flow criteria and daily usage criteria. The replacement system will improve reliability and efficiency by upgrading to modern pumps, controls and back-up systems.

Project Understanding

The NAU Capital Improvement Program and distribution system evaluation have recommended the replacement of the BPS system. The renovation design is complete and permitted by the FDEP. Time is of the essence considering the aging infrastructure at the BPS.

Scope of Services

Upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed from the Client, GAI proposes the following tasks to accomplish the above:

Task 1 - Bidding Assistance Services

The Consultant will assist the Client with the solicitation of formal bids for the reconstruction and rehabilitation of the NAU Booster Pump Station. The Consultant will finalize the bidding documents, to include the front-end documents, provided by Nassau County.

After acceptance by Authority of the Bidding Documents and the most recent opinion of probable Construction Cost as determined in the Final Design Phase Consultant shall:

- a) Finalize the front-end bid documents in preparation for bidding.
- b) Assist Authority in, organizing and conducting pre-Bid conference, if any, including preparation of meeting agendas and minutes.
- c) Issue Addenda as appropriate to clarify, correct, or change the Bidding Documents.
- d) Provide Information or assistance needed by Authority in the course of any negotiations with prospective contractors.
- e) Consult with Authority as to the acceptability of subcontractors, suppliers, and other individuals
 and entities proposed by prospective contractors for those portions of the Works as to which
 such acceptability is required by the Bidding Documents.
- f) Determine the acceptability of substitute materials and equipment proposed with substitution is necessary because the specified item is incompatible with the Project or fails to comply with applicable codes.
- g) Attend the Bid opening, prepare Bid Tabulation sheets, and assist Authority in evaluating Bids or proposals and in assembling and awarding contracts for the Work.
- h) Provide Authority with a recommendation of contract award.

The Bidding Phase will be considered complete upon contract award by the Authority to the successful bidder.
