Safety Study of Amelia Concourse Scope of Services

INTRODUCTION

Peters and Yaffee is pleased to provide Nassau County this proposal for traffic engineering services for Amelia Concourse. Our understanding of the needed services includes several safety-related evaluations resulting in a report which documents findings and recommendations for improvement. Vehicle speed studies will be provided by Nassau County. Our fee and schedule is based on our understanding as described in more detail as follows:

TRAFFIC STUDY SERVICES

A. Crash History and Trends

A collision summary and diagram will be provided using data using UF's Signal 4 Analytics program. Data will be collected from 1/1/2016 to 11/1/2021. Any significant "hot spots" and trends will be identified in the report.

B. Median Configurations

The existing median openings will be reviewed for consistency with FDOT Access Classification 5 Standards.

C. Access Management

The existing driveway connections will be reviewed against the County's roadway and drainage standards.

Vehicular Speeds

The County supplied travel speed data will be reviewed to determine the 85th percentile speed, median speed and 10-mile pace at two locations.

E. Potential Signal Locations

Existing and proposed development will be reviewed to determine potential signal locations considering FDOT Access Classification 5 standards.

F. Bike/Pedestrian Safety

The corridor will be reviewed to determine if there may be locations that would be appropriate for mid-block crosswalks or opportunities for roadway modifications that would provide additional bicycle or pedestrian safety. Bicycle and pedestrian counts are not included; therefore, any finding of a mid-block crossing location may need additional study.

G. Report

A report documenting the analysis and providing recommendations will be provided to Nassau County staff.

H. QC

Each step of the report will be reviewed by a qualified Peters and Yaffee employee prior to submittal

DELIVERABLES

The deliverable will be a safety study report that will document crash locations, median configurations, access management, vehicular speeds, potential signal locations, bicycle and pedestrian safety review and make recommendations to enhance safety along the corridor.

DURATION OF SERVICES

Within one week of contract approval, a registered professional engineer with Peters and Yaffee will perform a field review, then contact County Staff to discuss the study and ensure agreement on the details. Within 4 weeks, Peters and Yaffee will provide a completed report for Nassau County staff. Should staff have any comments to the report or desire assistance with community meetings, Peters and Yaffee will continue to be available to provide services.
