

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO NASSAU UF/IFAS EXTENSION SERVICE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 25th day of April, 2022, by and between Nassau County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (hereinafter "COUNTY"), and the University of Florida Board of Trustees, a public body corporate of the State of Florida (hereinafter "UNIVERSITY"), (hereinafter, when referred to individually as "Party" or collectively as "Parties").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Parties have previously entered into an AGREEMENT dated April 13, 2020, as amended on April 20, 2022, whereby the purpose of this AGREEMENT is to specify the terms under which each the UNIVERSITY and COUNTY will contribute to personnel, educational, technical and research information to Extension Services in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to establish their respective responsibilities regarding funding Extension Faculty personnel and programs; and responsibilities for the Miner Road extension property.

WHEREAS, the First Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding omitted certain language necessary to provide clarification for the Miner Road property general management and administrative provisions.

WHEREAS, the Parties here to desire to execute this Second Amendment and Modification to the AGREEMENT.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The term of this Second Amendment is agreed to start April 25, 2022.
2. Except as set forth in this Second Amendment and Modification, the AGREEMENT is unaffected and shall continue in full force and effect in accordance with its terms.

ARTICLE IV

Responsibilities

Replace entire 4(o) section as written below

4. General management and administrative provisions:


- o. As it relates to the COUNTY Miner Road property, any trails, gardens, statues, educational materials, if any, including signs, that are constructed shall.
 - i. Be approved and constructed by the Extension Office;
 - ii. Any modifications that were not in the original plans will be consistent with county code and applicable state and federal legislation;
 - iii. Shall not restrict the entry to the property or utilization of the parking areas;
 - iv. The plans for any item in paragraph (a) shall be provided to the COUNTY's Public Works Director for comment as to impact to

- parking or entry to the Miner Road property; and
- v. The construction, placement, or maintenance of any items enumerated in Article IV(4)(o)(i) and approved as described in Article IV(4)(o)(iv) shall be the responsibility of the County Extension Director using appropriate funding.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have made and executed this SECOND AMENDMENT to be executed on their behalf by their duly authorized representatives, all as of the date and year first written above.






