This Work Authorization is to the AGREEMENT between Nassau County and the Consultant known as the Interlocal Agreement between Nassau County and Florida Governmental Utility Authority for Water and Wastewater Utility Capital Project and related Grant/Loan Administration and Special Assessment Services, dated December 12, 2019. The services to be provided under this Work Authorization are as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Services Described as:

The Consultant shall assist the County in carrying out all services necessary to replace seven (7) fire hydrants and three (3) gate valves in the Nassau Amelia Utilities (NAU) distribution system. These services shall include:

- a) Removal and replacement of seven (7) fire hydrants and three (3) gate valves as identified below.
 - 1) Sea Marsh Golf Maintenance -FHA #203
 - 2) Ocean Blvd FHA #137
 - 3) Plantation Point FHA #126 and valve
 - 4) Club Villas FHA #213
 - 5) Turtle Dunes FHA #262 and valve
 - ♠ 6) Residence Ct FHA #275 and valve
 - 7) AIP Chapel FHA #216
- b) Public Boil Water Notices and associated clearance samples.
- c) Site restoration.

During the annual fire hydrant maintenance program these hydrants were identified as defective and require replacement. Due to the safety and liability concerns with having hydrants bagged out of service replacement is recommended as soon as possible.

ARTICLE 2. Time Schedule

The Consultant shall begin upon execution of this Work Authorization and shall complete the replacements by 02/16/2023.

ARTICLE 3. Budget

The Consultant will perform the scope of services outlined herein for a Not-to-Exceed amount of \$64,503.18. A copy of the related FGUA/USWSC Work Authorization is attached hereto for reference.

Article 4. Other Provisions

The Services covered by this Work Authorization will be performed in accordance with the provisions set forth in the AGREEMENT referenced above and any of its attachments or schedules. Additional terms or agreement provisions whether submitted purposely or inadvertently, shall have no force or effect. This Work Authorization will become a part of the referenced AGREEMENT when executed by both parties.

A. SUMMARY OF SERVICES TO BE RENDERED

USWSC will provide all necessary labor, equipment & materials to replace (7) hydrants and (3) gate valves in the Nassau Amelia Utilities system. During the annual hydrant maintenance program, seven (7) defective fire hydrants were identified that require replacement. These include:

1)Sea Marsh Golf Maintenance -FHA #203 2)Ocean Blvd - FHA #137 3)Plantation Point - FHA #126 and valve 4)Club Viflas - FHA #213 5)Turtle Dunes - FHA #262 and valve 6)Residence Ct - FHA #275 and valve 7)AIP Chapel - FHA #216

The fire hydrant replacement for Plantation Point requires a PBWN due to the lack of isolation valves for the area. Based on current general price escalation trends, and timeliness in parts delivery, a contingency fund of 10% has been added.





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
