This Work Authorization is to the AGREEMENT between Nassau County and S2L, Incorporated ("Vendor") for Continuing Contract for Professional Engineering Services-Solid Waste Landfills and Other Related Ancillary Facilities for Nassau County, Florida, dated July 26, 2019. The services to be provided under this Work Authorization are as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Services Described as:

This Work Authorization (WA) tasks S2L, Incorporated (S2Li) to provide qualified professional labor to complete groundwater and surface water sampling, laboratory analyses, and reporting to support Nassau County in compliance with Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP" or "Department") permit conditions and the requirements of FDEP Rule 62-701, FAC. S2Li Project Team will prepare two (2) Semi-Annual Water Quality Monitoring Report for the West Nassau and one Annual (Spring Event) Water Quality Monitoring Report for Lofton Creek Landfills during FY2023 (October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023). S2Li Project Team will use groundwater level measurements and field and laboratory results from analyses of collected groundwater and surface water samples to complete the semi-annual FDEP data reporting requirements. The Monitoring Reports will be prepared in accordance with the requirements of FDEP Rule 62- 701.510(8)(a) and the landfill's current FDEP MPIS. The Semi-Annual Monitoring Reports will include, but may not be limited to:

a. facility basic information, sample collection dates, and laboratory analyses dates;

- b. Original laboratory report results, QA/QC notations for analytical results, method detection limits, applicable water quality standards and STORET code numbers for all parameters analyzed;
- c. Tabulated water level and field parameter measurement data;
- d. Map showing monitoring locations for groundwater and surface water monitoring points with identification numbers;
- e. Water level measurements and measuring point elevations at each monitoring point reported to a precision of 0.01 feet NGVD;
- f. Updated groundwater contour maps for the upper and lower monitoring zones, with contour intervals no greater than 1 foot, indicating groundwater elevations and direction of groundwater flow;
- g. Summary of any water quality standards or criteria that are exceeded, and;
- h. Electronic Data Delivery (EDD) prepared in FDEP ADaPT format. Additional sampling for testing may include leachate samples collected from the French Drain pump(s) and leachate storage tanks.

in accordance with the Scope of Services, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit** "A".

ARTICLE 2. Time Schedule

Vendor anticipates their earliest starting date to be 10/1/22 from receipt of execution of this Work Authorization with an estimated duration of twelve (12) months to complete the Scope of Work.

ARTICLE 3. Budget

The cost estimate to conduct the Work as described in the below-listed Scope of Services is \$49,999.69. Costs will be invoiced on a time and materials basis. The County will be notified when the overall project budget is nearing its limit. Vendor's fee amounts are detailed further in **Exhibit "B"**. Vendor will be using rates previously established under Contract CM-2685.

ARTICLE 4. Other Provisions

The Services covered by this Work Authorization will be performed in accordance with the provisions set forth in the AGREEMENT referenced above and any of its attachments or schedules. Additional terms or contract provisions whether submitted purposely or inadvertently, shall have no force or effect. This Work Authorization will become a part of the referenced AGREEMENT when executed by both parties.

Any Work Authorization entered into prior to expiration or termination set forth in the AGREEMENT shall continue in effect through the earlier of: (i) the date all of the Services thereunder have been fully completed and accepted by Nassau County, or (ii) until such time as such Work Authorization expires or is terminated in accordance with its terms or is terminated pursuant to Article 2 hereof.

FDEP Semi-Annual Water Quality Monitoring Services (Sampling, Laboratory Analyses, and Reporting Services) for the West Nassau and Lofton Creek Closed Landfills Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 Sampling Events

Nassau County S2L, Inc.'s Contract and Work Authorization Number: CM2685-WA33 S2Li Project Number: 22-981

Work Authorization Service Period: Fiscal Year 2023 (October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023)

This Work Authorization will provide sampling, testing and reporting services by S2L, Incorporated ("S2Li") and The Colinas Group ("TCG") (S2Li's hydrogeological subconsultant) collectively known as the "S2Li Project Team" for the West Nassau and Lofton Creek Landfills in accordance to the respective landfill's water quality Monitoring Plan Implementation Schedules ("MPIS") within the permits for each site. As an additional services option, the S2Li Project Team will also sample and analyze the water quality at the wells along Meadowfield Bluff Road and provide the results for County documentation. Under the scope of services for this Work Authorization, S2Li Project Team will perform the following:

SCOPE OF SERVICES

S2Li Project Team will provide qualified professional labor to complete groundwater and surface water sampling, laboratory analyses, and reporting to support Nassau County in compliance with Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP" or "Department") permit conditions and the requirements of FDEP Rule 62-701, FAC. S2Li Project Team will prepare two (2) Semi-Annual Water Quality Monitoring Report for the West Nassau and one Annual (Spring Event) Water Quality Monitoring Report for Lofton Creek Landfills during FY2023 (October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023). S2Li Project Team will use groundwater level measurements and field and laboratory results from analyses of collected groundwater and surface water samples to complete the semi-annual FDEP data reporting requirements.

The Monitoring Reports will be prepared in accordance with the requirements of FDEP Rule 62-701.510(8)(a) and the landfill's current FDEP MPIS. The Semi-Annual Monitoring Reports will include, but may not be limited to:

- a. Facility basic information, sample collection dates, and laboratory analyses dates;
- b. Original laboratory report results, QA/QC notations for analytical results, method detection limits, applicable water quality standards and STORET code numbers for all parameters analyzed;
- c. Tabulated water level and field parameter measurement data;
- d. Map showing monitoring locations for groundwater and surface water monitoring points with identification numbers;
- e. Water level measurements and measuring point elevations at each monitoring point reported to a precision of 0.01 feet NGVD;

- f. Updated groundwater contour maps for the upper and lower monitoring zones, with contour intervals no greater than 1 foot, indicating groundwater elevations and direction of groundwater flow;
- g. Summary of any water quality standards or criteria that are exceeded, and;
- h. Electronic Data Delivery (EDD) prepared in FDEP ADaPT format.

Additional sampling for testing may include leachate samples collected from the French Drain pump(s) and leachate storage tanks.

S2Li Project Team will complete two semi-annual monitoring and reporting events for the West Nassau Closed Landfill and an annual monitoring and reporting event for the Lofton Creek Closed Landfill. Expected sampling to be conducted in the Fall (October through December) 2022 for the West Nassau Landfill only and Spring (April through June) 2023 for both the West Nassau and Lofton Creek Landfills. Water quality monitoring reports will be prepared in draft form for review and comment by Nassau County and, on approval, will be submitted to the FDEP through the Department's ESSA website. Electronic copies of the original submittal will be transmitted to Nassau County to complete each monitoring event.

Optional Additional Scope of Services for Lofton Creek Landfill

Nassau County may desire to monitor water quality from time to time at four (4) existing monitoring wells located along Meadowfield Bluffs Road located to the west of the Lofton Creek Closed Landfill. At the County's direction, S2Li Project Team will sample these wells one time during the time of the spring sampling event of the Lofton Creek Landfill monitoring wells, analyze the samples in the laboratory and prepare a letter report presenting monitoring results with recommendations for further actions, if any, on the part of Nassau County. Analysis will include those listed in the landfill's FDEP MPIS for testing at facility background monitoring wells.

SCHEDULE

Work under the Scope of Services provided above will begin upon receipt of the signed Work Authorization. It is estimated that it will take approximately 30 days to complete and deliver the draft Semi-Annual Water Quality Monitoring Reports from the time of receipt of laboratory analytical results. S2Li Project Team will prepare one (1) draft copy of each report for review and approval of Nassau County. Upon approval from Nassau County, S2Li Project Team will prepare the final report and submit the electronic data deliverable in ADaPT format to the FDEP Tallahassee Office and Nassau County.

Work under the Scope of Services provided below will occur during the period of October 1, 2022 and run through this service period ending September 30, 2023.

COST ESTIMATE

A detailed breakdown of costs for completion of semi-annual water quality monitoring activities at both landfills is provided on the attached Cost Summary Sheet. Annual costs for field sampling, laboratory analyses and report preparation for submittal to the FDEP in accordance with landfill closure permit requirements are provided in the attachment to this proposal.

West Nassau Landfill costs include leachate sampling and testing from one of the French Drain pump stations and one composite sample at the leachate storage tanks.

Potential costs for re-sampling of groundwater and surface water are provided for rare instances where an original sample analysis confirmation is considered advisable. Costs are presented as Contingent DW/SW Resampling in the Cost Sheet Summary. Resampling of any monitoring well or surface water station will only occur with prior approval from Nassau County.

The cost estimate to conduct the Work as described in the above-listed Scope of Services is **\$49,999.69** including the optional additional services for Lofton Creek Landfill. A detailed breakdown for each task in conjunction with the estimated labor hours, contract labor rates, and expenses are included in the attached Exhibit 1 for the S2Li Project Team. Costs incurred will be invoiced on a time and material basis. The County will be notified when the overall project budget is nearing its limit.

Water quality monitoring reports will be prepared in draft for review and comment by S2Li and Nassau County and, on approval, will be submitted to the FDEP through the Department's ESSA website. Electronic copies of the original submittal will be transmitted to S2Li to complete the monitoring event.

TCG proposes to complete the above Scope of Services on a not-to-exceed fee basis in accordance with our personnel standard hourly rates. A summary of professional labor fees and subcontract laboratory costs to complete the work tasks is presented below:

Analytes will include those listed in the landfill's FDEP Monitoring Plan Implementation Schedule for testing at facility background monitoring wells.

Annual costs for field sampling, laboratory analyses and report preparation for submittal to the FDEP in accordance with landfill closure permit requirements are provided in the attachment to this proposal.

Costs for groundwater analyses include the addition of tests for Boron and Hydrogen Sulfide at specific monitoring wells at the West Nassau and Lofton Creek landfills to meet anticipated upcoming FDEP rule revisions for monitoring at unlined Class I landfills. TCG will include both parameters for sampling in the first semi-annual monitoring event following the date of final and official rule revision by the FDEP. Laboratory analysis costs (\$40/sample) for boron and Hydrogen Sulfide together are included in the Cost Summary Sheet.
