Request for Time Extension

Dear Ms. Evans:

A project agreement between the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and Nassau County for paving improvements to Pratt Siding Road from CR-115 to US-1 began on April 11, 2019 with a planned completion date of June 30, 2024.

The project plans are complete. Extensive acquisition of additional needed right-of-way is needed for the project and under way. Nassau County has proposed revisions to the plans to reduce the required the number of different property owner acquisitions required for the project by half.

Understanding the needed work to deliver the project, an 18-month extension is proposed for the existing agreement. This should allow sufficient time to finalize the revisions, acquire the remaining necessary right-of-way along the segment, and complete construction. This extension would establish a new agreement termination date of December 31, 2025.
