CSI Geo, Inc. (CSI Geo) is pleased to present this technical approach for the subject project.

PROJECT BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND PROJECT DESCRIPTION

We understand that a new fire station is proposed at the southeast corner of Old Nassauville Road and Hardy Allen Road in Nassau County, Florida. The proposed construction will include a new one-story fire station building, parking, and pond.

TECHNICAL APPROACH

It is the intent of this contract to acquire a complete and accurate geotechnical investigation for the identified project through obtaining boring logs, performing soil testing, and incorporating this and other pertinent information into a comprehensive subsurface investigation report for the project site.

SCOPE OF PROPOSED SERVICES

The geotechnical exploration will consist of field exploratory borings, laboratory testing, and a geotechnical analysis of the collected data. A narrative outline of the work plan is presented in the following section.

WORK PLAN

Field Exploration

Fire Station Building & Parking – The proposed exploration along the proposed building and parking areas will consist of 30 feet deep Standard Penetration Test (SPT) borings for a total of 3 SPT borings and 6 feet auger borings for a total of 2 auger borings. The SPT borings will be grouted upon completion. In addition, undisturbed soil samples will be retrieved to provide soil parameters for foundation design.

Pond – The proposed exploration at the location of the proposed pond will consist of one 20 feet deep SPT boring with continuous sampling. One permeability test will be performed to provide infiltration rates.

Soil samples will be classified, containerized, marked in the field and returned to the laboratory for visual inspection and classification by the geotechnical engineer using the Unified Soil Classification Systems (USCS).

Laboratory Testing

Laboratory classification and index soil tests will be performed as necessary on selected soil samples obtained from the exploration. Specific tests to be performed are Moisture Content, Organic Content, Percent Fines, Atterberg Limits, Consolidation, LBR testing, and Corrosion testing.

Engineering/Support Services

A geotechnical engineer, registered in the State of Florida, will direct the geotechnical exploration and provide engineering analysis and evaluation of the site and subsurface conditions with respect to the planned construction.
