FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR THE REGIONAL FOOD BANK OF NORTHEAST
FLORIDA, INC.
FISCAL VEAD 2024/2025

FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into by and between the BOARD OF COUTNY

COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida,

hereinafter referred to as "County", and REGIONAL FOOD BANK OF NORTHEAST

FLORIDA, INC., d/b/a FEEDING NORTHEAST FLORIDA, 1116 Edgewood Avenue N.,

Units D/E, Jacksonville, Florida, 32254, hereinafter referred to as "FNEFL".

WHEREAS, FNEFL supplies charitable food and essential safety net services to Nassau

County and eleven surrounding counties; and

WHEREAS, FNEFL prepares for quick and efficient responses to local disasters such as

summer heat, hurricane, flood, tornadoes, extreme cold, people-made disasters and power outage

emergencies by leveraging their facilities, experience with logistics and transportation, and sourcing

emergency food and water; and

WHEREAS, FNEFL partners with local Emergency Operations Centers, United Way of

Northeast Florida COAD as first responders by providing immediate food and water assistance and

recovery efforts focused to Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the County is desirous of entering into a funding agreement with FNEFL, in

order to fund said services.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants and

agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

SECTION 1. RECITALS.

1.1 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein, in their

entirety, by this reference.

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SECTION 2. FUNDING.

2.1 For the services outlined in this Agreement, the County shall pay the FNEFL the sum of Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$5,000.00), which shall be paid in quarterly installments, during the months of December, February, May and August of the fiscal year. Appropriations necessary for the funding of this Agreement beyond FY 2024/2025 shall be subject to the budget and appropriation by the County during the regular budget process.

- 2.2 In performing its obligation under this Agreement, FNEFL shall be at all times acting in the capacity of an independent contractor and not as an officer, employee or agent of the County.
- 2.3 FNEFL shall submit simultaneously to the County Manager and the Clerk an annual accounting record acceptable to the Clerk on or before May 1st of each fiscal year in which FNEFL received funding from the County. Additionally, FNEFL shall make its books available for inspection by a designee of the County upon reasonable notice. Failure of FNEFL to provide the annual accounting record by the time specified shall result in the revocation of granting of further funds and reimbursement of funds distributed during the year for which no report was submitted.

SECTION 3. TERM OF AGREEMENT AND OPTION TO AMEND

- 3.1 The term of this Agreement shall commence on October 1, 2024 and terminate on September 30, 2025, unless terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party, subject to completion of all previous and outstanding billings.
- 3.2 This Agreement may be amended only in writing by mutual consent of the parties.

SECTION 4. THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT, FLORIDA PUBLIC

RECORDS LAW.

- 4.1 All facilities, programs and services shall be compliant with the Florida Accessibility Code and the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Failure to provide facilities, programs, and services that are compliant with both the Florida Accessibility Code and the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) shall be considered a breach of the Agreement and may result in termination of this Agreement.
- 4.2 The County is a public agency subject to Chapter 119, Florida Statutes. IF FNEFL HAS QUESTIONS REGARDING THE APPLICATION OF CHAPTER 119, FLORIDA STATUTES, TO FNEFL TO PROVIDE PUBLIC RECORDS RELATING TO THIS AGREEMENT, CONTACT THE CUSTODIAN OF PUBLIC RECORDS AT (904) 530-6090, RECORDS@NASSAUCOUNTYFL.COM, 96135 NASSAU PLACE, SUITE 6, YULEE, FLORIDA 32097. Under this Agreement, to the extent that FNEFL is providing goods and/or services to the County, and pursuant to Section 119.0701, Florida Statutes, FNEFL shall:
- a. Keep and maintain public records required by the County to provide goods and/or services.
- b. Upon request from the County's custodian of public records, provide the County with a copy of the requested records or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time at a cost that does not exceed the cost provided in this chapter or as otherwise provided by law.
- c. Ensure that public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public

records disclosure requirements are not disclosed except as authorized by law for the duration of the Agreement term and following completion of the Agreement if FNEFL does not transfer the records to the County.

- d. Upon completion of the Agreement, transfer, at no cost, to the County all public records in possession of FNEFL or keep and maintain public records required by the County FNEFL to perform the service. If NHEFL transfers all public records to the County upon completion of the Agreement, FNEFL shall destroy any duplicate public records that are exempt or confidential and exempt from public records disclosure requirements. If the FNEFL keeps and maintains public records upon completion of the Agreement, the FNEFL shall meet all applicable requirements for retaining public records. All records stored electronically shall be provided to the County, upon request from the County's custodian of public records, in a format that is compatible with the information technology systems of the County.
 - 4.3 A request to inspect or copy public records relating to the County's contract for goods and/or services shall be made directly to the County. If the County does not possess the requested records, the County shall immediately notify the FNEFL of the request, and the FNEFL shall provide the records to the public agency or allow the records to be inspected or copied within a reasonable time.
 - 4.4 If FNEFL does not comply with the County's request for records, the County shall enforce the Agreement provisions in accordance with the Agreement.
 - 4.5 If FNEFL fails to provide the public records to the County within a reasonable time, the FNEFL may be subject to penalties under Section 119.10, Florida Statutes.
 - 4.6 If a civil action is filed against the FNEFL to compel production of public records relating to the Agreement, the Court shall assess and award against FNEFL the reasonable

costs of enforcement, including reasonable attorney fees if:

(a) The Court determines that the FNEFL unlawfully refused to comply with the public records request within a reasonable time; and

- (b) At least eight (8) business days before filing the action, the plaintiff provided written notice of the public records request, including a statement that FNEFL has not complied with the request, to the County and to FNEFL.
- 4.7 A notice complies with this Section, if it is sent to the County's custodian of public records and to FNEFL at the FNEFL address listed on its Agreement with the County or to FNEFL registered agent. Such notices shall be sent to the address listed above for each party.
- 4.8 If FNEFL complies with a public records request within eight (8) business days after the notice is sent, FNEFL is not liable for the reasonable costs of enforcement.

SECTION 5. TERMINATION.

- 5.1 If FNEFL fails to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement, and if such default remains uncured for more than fifteen (15) days after written notice was provided by the County, then the County may, without prejudice to any right or remedy the County may have, terminate this Agreement and cessation of payment.
- 5.2 The County reserves the right to terminate this Agreement in whole or part by giving FNEFL written notice at least thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of termination.

SECTION 6. GOVERNING LAW, VENUE AND COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS.

6.1 This Agreement shall be deemed to have been executed and entered into within the State of Florida and any dispute arising hereunder, shall be governed, interpreted and

construed according to the laws of the State of Florida, the Ordinances of Nassau County,

and any applicable federal statutes, rules and regulations. Any and all litigation arising

under this Agreement shall be brought in Nassau County, Florida, and any trial shall be

non-jury. Any mediation, pursuant to litigation, shall occur in Nassau County, Florida.

6.2 FNEFL shall comply with any applicable regulatory requirements including

federal, state, and local laws, rules, regulations codes, orders, criteria and standards.

SECTION 7. NO ASSIGNMENT.

7.1 FNEFL shall not assign, sublet, convey or transfer its interest in this Agreement

without the prior written consent of the County.

SECTION 8. HUMAN TRAFFICKING AFFIDAVIT.

8.1 In accordance with Section 787.06, Florida Statutes, the Vendor shall provide the

County an affidavit, on a form approved by the County, signed by an officer or a

representative of the Vendor under penalty of perjury attesting that the Vendor does not

use coercion for labor or services as defined in Section 787.06, Florida Statutes.
