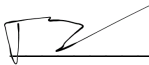

Project Overview

SAM Surveying and Mapping, LLC (SAM) proposes to provide Boundary, and Topographic Survey of Yulee Regional Park expansion – 102 acres 50-3N-27-0000-0001-0380 in Nassau County, Florida. The approximate project limits are shown on attached Exhibit “A”. SAM will complete the boundary, ground truthing and control surveys using conventional survey methods and complete the topographic survey using UAS lidar verified by conventional ground truthing procedures.

Scope of Services – Boundary, SUE Quality Level B, and Topographic Survey

SAM will perform a Boundary, and Topographic Survey of Yulee Regional Park expansion – 102 acres 50-3N-27-0000-0001-0380 as shown on attached Exhibit “A”.

1. The survey shall be in the North American Vertical Datum of 1988, NAVD88.
2. The Survey deliverable is to include all surveyed points in a LandXML file or a comma delimited ASCII file format (point number, northing, easting, elevation, description). Also, to be included is the CIVIL 3D surface in a LandXML file including all break lines/feature lines used in preparing the surface. Otherwise, the surveyor is to provide a 3D line generated triangular irregular network (TIN) of the existing surface.
3. Surveyor to provide a complete boundary survey with bearings and distances noted. Surveyor shall also provide line/curve table data when applicable and a legal description of the subject property.
4. The survey shall include:
 - All adjacent/abutting properties. (Include owner name, parcel no. and record book and page)
 - All adjacent/crossing roadways, railroads, etc. and label with material, roadway width and -of-way width. Show both sides of the right-of-way. Recover and record posted speed limits on all roads adjacent to and crossing subject property.
 - All easements across or adjacent/abutting the subject property.
 - All delineated jurisdictional wetlands. Include elevations as recovered at flagging as well as interior wetland spot elevations.
 - All streams, ditches, swales, etc. across or adjacent/abutting the subject property. Provide elevations along the centerline, bottoms of bank, edges of water, and tops of bank.
 - All ponds and bodies of water across or adjacent/abutting the subject property. Provide elevations at top of bank, edge of water and bottom of pond.
 - A topo grid at 50 feet minimum on-site (including within wetland interior).
 - A topo grid at 100 feet minimum off-site.
 - A topo grid at 25 feet minimum on all pavements. Include centerline of roadway, edge of pavement, edge of shoulder, and side ditches as outlined above. If roadway has curb and gutter surveyor to include additional survey shots at the flow line and the back of curb.
 - All existing structures (buildings, decks, sheds, etc.) including finished floor elevations.
 - All drainage structures across the subject property. Include structure type (MH, inlet, headwall, MES, etc.), pipe size, material, and all inverts (specified with direction of flow).
 - All drainage structures adjacent to the subject property within sufficient range to allow the engineer to establish existing drainage patterns and volumes. Include structure type (MH, inlet, headwall, MES, etc.), pipe size, material, and all inverts (specified with direction of flow).
 - A minimum of 2 benchmarks per surveyed site. Benchmarks to be annotated with benchmark I.D., northing, easting, elevation, description, and datum.

No trees will be located.
5. Underground Utilities to be included in the survey (at a minimum) include:
Existing Water, Existing Reclaimed Water, Existing Sanitary Sewer (including inverts), Existing Gas
Existing Fiber Optic, Existing Underground Electric, Existing Underground Telephone, Existing Underground Cable TV



Project Deliverables

- Signed/sealed pdf file and cad file of the survey with the following:
 - There shall be NO splines used in the creation of the AutoCAD file.
 - The surveyor shall provide all AutoCAD files in 2022 file format or earlier.
 - The survey plans to be at a maximum scale of 1" = 50'
 - All blocks used in the creation of the AutoCAD file shall be created on layer 0 (zero) and have
 - linetype, color, and line weight assigned as "bylayer".
 - All contours to have the correct "Z" value (elevation) assigned to the AutoCAD entity.
 - The surveyor shall provide a legend and list of abbreviations used on the survey.

SAM will begin the field work within 1 week of notice to proceed and submit final survey within 8 weeks of notice to proceed.

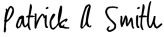

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Withdrawing your consent
