ORDINANCE 2005 - 27

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 74-29, WHICH SET FORTH THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON THE AMELIA ISLAND PARKWAY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on March 26, 1974, the Board of County Commissioners approved Ordinance 74-29; and

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized to set speed limits upon County roads pursuant to <u>Florida Statutes</u>, Section 316.189(2); and

WHEREAS, the Board has found it necessary to amend Ordinance 74-29.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 11th day of April, 2005, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 74-29 shall be amended as follows:

- 1. The maximum speed limit on that certain road in Nassau County known as the Amelia Island Parkway within the unincorporated area of Nassau County shall be 35 45 miles per hour, and that the County Engineer Director of Engineering Services is hereby directed to obtain clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits and to post such signs in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zone.

filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
