ORDINANCE 94 - 19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 74-34, AS AMENDED, WHICH PROVIDED FOR THE TAKING UP AND IMPOUNDMENT OF DOGS AND OTHER ANIMALS, AND ESTABLISHED AN ANIMAL CONTROL AUTHORITY TO ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE 74-34, AS AMENDED; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 8, IMPOUND FEES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board has been made aware that the fees set forth in Ordinance 74-34, as amended, should be further amended; and WHEREAS, the Board feels this increase to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this <u>14th</u> day of <u>March</u>, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 74-34, as amended, be further amended as follows:

1. Section 8. IMPOUND FEES:

Any animal impounded hereunder may be reclaimed as herein provided upon payment by the owner to the Animal Warden or Animal Control Authority of the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for a first offense, seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for a second offense, and for a third offense the matter shall be submitted to the Code Enforcement Board for action for each animal, and the additional sum of \$2.00 ten dollars (\$10.00) for each day such animal has been kept at the Animal Control Authority. All fees set forth herein shall be collected by the Animal Warden for the County of Nassau or Animal Control Authority. <u>Hunting dogs</u> shall be excluded from this provision.
