

ORDINANCE 2003 - 61


AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 2003-27, IN ITS ENTIRETY, WHICH EXEMPTED FROM TAXATION AN INCREASE IN THE ASSESSED VALUE OF HOMESTEAD PROPERTY RESULTING FROM CONSTRUCTING OR RECONSTRUCTING LIVING QUARTERS FOR PARENTS OR GRANDPARENTS WHO ARE 62 YEARS OLD OR OLDER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that Ordinance 2003-27 be rescinded.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 24th day of November, 2003, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 2003-27 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

This Ordinance is enacted on November 24, 2003, upon the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of County Commissioners and shall become effective on November 24, 2003, and upon its being filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
