ORDINANCE 92- 22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 81-26, AS AMENDED, WHICH SET FORTH RULES AND REGULATIONS TO IMPROVE PUBLIC SAFETY BY PROMOTING THE CONTROL OF FIRE HAZARDS; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 1. SOUTHERN STANDARD CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners has found it in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that Ordinance 81-26, as amended, be further amended to include the 1991 edition of the Southern Standard Fire Prevention Code and the 1988 edition of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 101, Life Safety Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 8 day of June 1992, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 81-26, as amended, be further amended as follows:

- 1. <u>SECTION 1. SOUTHERN STANDARD CODE</u>: The Southern Standard Fire Prevention Code, as adopted by the Southern Building Code Congress International, being particularly the <u>current 1991</u> thereof and the whole thereof, and the same <u>is</u> hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set forth at length herein, and from the date on which this ordinance shall take effect, the provisions therein shall be controlling.
- 2. <u>SECTION 2. NATIONAL FIRE PROTECTION CODE</u>: The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) 101, Life Safety Code, 1985 1988 Edition, except as superseded by Florida Administrative Code, Section 4-A and Section 633, Florida Statutes, is hereby adopted.

3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its filing with the Secretary of State.
