

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-193

A RESOLUTION, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 99-02, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2002-023, AS AMENDED, THAT INDICATES THOSE ORDINANCES THAT THE CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD REQUESTS AUTHORITY TO HOLD HEARINGS ON AND IMPOSE FINES FOR VIOLATIONS; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 99-02, Section 8, the Chairman of the Code Enforcement Board shall indicate to the Board of County Commissioners the ordinances that the Code Enforcement Board requests authority to hold hearings and impose fines.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 18th day of November, 2002, that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida hereby amends Resolution No. 2002-023, as amended, as follows:

1. The Code Enforcement Board shall hold hearings and impose fines against violators of the following ordinances:
 - a. Ordinance 90-19, as amended, regarding beach concessions
 - b. Ordinance 76-5, as amended, regarding animal control
 - c. Ordinance 97-19, as amended, the Zoning Code
 - d. Ordinance 99-17, as amended, regarding roads and drainage
 - e. Ordinance 97-14, as amended, regarding rights-of-way

- f. Ordinance 89-10, as amended, known as the "Nuisance Ordinance"
- g. Ordinance 89-10, regarding signage for the unincorporated areas of Amelia Island, Florida
- h. Ordinance 2002-29, regarding off-island billboards

2. Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of County Commissioners.


