ORDINANCE NO. 93 - 17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 83-19, AS AMENDED, WHICH ESTABLISHED A COMPREHENSIVE ZONING CODE AND ZONING MAPS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED PORTION OF NASSAU COUNTY; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING ARTICLE 19, CONDITIONAL USES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have found it necessary to further amend Ordinance 83-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this <u>26th</u> day of <u>July</u>, 1993, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 83-19, as amended, be further amended as follows:

- 1. <u>ARTICLE 15: COMMERCIAL, NEIGHBORHOOD: CN</u>
 Section 15.04 Conditional Uses.
- A. Antique shops.
- B. Plant Nurseries.
- C. Sale of alcoholic beverages with alcoholic content not more than fourteen percent (14%) for consumption, either onpremises or off-premises.
- D. Gasoline dispensing facility containing not more than one (1) pump island with not more than four (4) gasoline and/or fuel pumps; provided no repairs or other automobile services are permitted.
- E. Multi-family dwelling when located above a permitted principal use as listed above.
- F. Fraternal clubs, lodges, and social and recreational clubs.
 - G. Video game parlor and/or game rooms.

- H. <u>Day nursery, child care center, or private school, as</u>
 provided in Section 26.15.
 - 2. <u>ARTICLE 19: COMMERCIAL, PROFESSIONAL AND OFFICE: CPO</u>
 Section 19.03 Conditional Uses
- A. Uses permitted in the CPO District which are excluded by limitations on such uses.
- B. Medical or dental clinics, hospital, sanitariums, child care centers, private schools, and churches (except temporary revival establishes), provided that minimum parcel size is not less than two (2) acres.
- C. Medical or dental laboratories and establishments, manufacturing prosthetic appliances, dentures, eye glasses, hearing aids and similar products.

3. **EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
