A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THAT A PROPOSITION CALLING FOR AT LARGE REPRESENTATION WITHIN THE COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICTS BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORATE

1. The Supervisor of Elections is hereby directed to place on the ballot, for the general election to be held in 1992, as follows:

Shall the five (5) members of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, be elected to office at large by electors residing county wide?
