A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, WITHDRAWING FROM THE FLORIDA GOVERNMENTAL UTILITY AUTHORITY (FGUA); PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners joined the Florida Governmental Utility Authority (FGUA) on December 1, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County has benefited greatly as a member of the FGUA; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has recently acquired the Florida Water Services facility on Amelia Island; and


WHEREAS, there are no FGUA facilities in Nassau County.
