

ORDINANCE 92 - 15



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 90-19, REGULATING ATLANTIC BEACH AND NASSAU SOUND BEACH CONCESSIONS ON NASSAU COUNTY BEACHES WITHIN THE AREAS UNDER NASSAU COUNTY'S CONTROL ON AMELIA ISLAND; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION VI, CONCESSION FEE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, recognizes that the Atlantic beach areas and Nassau Sound area on Amelia Island are a recreation area; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County adopted Ordinance 90-19; and

WHEREAS, the Board has found it necessary to amend Ordinance 90-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 11th day of May, 1992, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 90-19, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

1. SECTION VI. CONCESSION FEE


(A) Concession Fee. Each on-beach concessionaire shall pay to the County a minimum annual fee of ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ one hundred dollars (\$100.00) on or before October 1. Each off-beach concession shall pay to the County a minimum annual fee of ~~\$50.00~~ one hundred dollars (\$100.00). A late charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be imposed upon the minimum fee. Failure to remit the minimum fee on or before November 1 of each year shall result in automatic suspension of the authorization to operate until such time as the fee plus late charges have been received by

the County.

2. SECTION XII. EFFECTIVE DATE


This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
