ORDINANCE 2005 - 57

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 94-14, WHICH REGULATES FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 4. SERVICE FEES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County to amending Ordinance 94-14.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this <u>25th</u> day of July, 2005, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 94-14 shall be amended as follows:

1. SECTION 4. SERVICE FEES

- 1. No service fee shall be charged for the first three (3) false alarms per 12-month period, calculated from the date of the first such alarm.
- 2. Each false alarm in excess of three (3) and up to and including six (6) within a 12-month period shall result in a service fee of \$50.00 \$75.00 per false alarm, payable within thirty (30) days from the date of invoice.
- 3. Each false alarm in excess of six (6) within a 12-month period shall result in a service fee of \$100.00 \$150.00 per false alarm, payable within thirty (30) days from the date of invoice.

- 4. The Fire Department shall determine whose the hours and dates during which lightning or severe weather may impact the proper operation of an alarm system, and false alarms occasioned thereby shall not result in issuance of a warning notice or imposition of a service fee.
- 2. **SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE**. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
