

ORDINANCE 2005 - 57

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 94-14, WHICH REGULATES FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 4. SERVICE FEES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County to amending Ordinance 94-14.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 25th day of July, 2005, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 94-14 shall be amended as follows:

1. **SECTION 4. SERVICE FEES**

1. No service fee shall be charged for the first three (3) false alarms per 12-month period, calculated from the date of the first such alarm.

2. Each false alarm in excess of three (3) and up to and including six (6) within a 12-month period shall result in a service fee of ~~\$50.00~~ \$75.00 per false alarm, payable within thirty (30) days from the date of invoice.

3. Each false alarm in excess of six (6) within a 12-month period shall result in a service fee of ~~\$100.00~~ \$150.00 per false alarm, payable within thirty (30) days from the date of invoice.

4. The Fire Department shall determine ~~whse~~ the hours and dates during which lightning or severe weather may impact the proper operation of an alarm system, and false alarms occasioned thereby shall not result in issuance of a warning notice or imposition of a service fee.

2. **SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the Secretary of State.


