

ORDINANCE 2005 - 58

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 94-18, WHICH PROVIDED FOR THE INSTALLATION AND PLACEMENT OF FIRE HYDRANTS; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION IV. APPEAL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County to amend Ordinance 94-18.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 25th day of July, 2005, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 94-18 shall be amended as follows:

1. **IV. APPEAL.** The decision of the spacing of fire hydrants may be appealed to the Board of County Commissioners within thirty (30) days of the ~~Public Safety Director~~ Fire Chief or his designee determining the spacing requirements. The Board should schedule the appeal at its next regularly scheduled meeting upon receipt of the appeal.

2. **V. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the

Secretary of State.


