

ORDINANCE 94 - 28

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 92-20, WHICH ESTABLISHED RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE GRANTING OF PERMITS FOR PUBLIC DISPLAY OF FIREWORKS; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION V. HOURS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes, Section 791.02, provides authority to the Board of County Commissioners to adopt rules and regulations for the public display of fireworks; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been made aware of a need to amended Ordinance 92-20.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 9th day of May, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, Ordinance 92-20 is hereby amended as follows:


1. SECTION V. HOURS

It shall be unlawful to use or explode fireworks before 7:00 a.m. and after 10:00 p.m., unless approved by the Board of County Commissioners. Said times shall not be applicable on National holidays.

2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.


