RESOLUTION NO. 2000- 59

A RESOLUTION SETTING FORTH POLICIES REGARDING GOLF CART CROSSINGS ON ROADWAYS WITHIN SUBDIVISIONS

WHEREAS, staff has requested that the Board of County Commissioners adopt a policy as regards roadways within subdivisions that have golf cart crossings; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after receiving a report from staff, concurs that a policy is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 27th day of March, 2000, as follows:

- 1. If on grade crossings are provided within subdivisions and the roads are to be dedicated to the county, those portions of the roadways that contain on grade crossings for golf carts shall remain private or under the maintenance of a Homeowners Association Agreement.
- Roadways with golf cart crossings shall only be considered for dedication to the county if grade separated golf cart crossings are provided.
- 3. The policy set forth in this Resolution shall be effective immediately and staff is directed to advise owners of said subdivisions of the adoption of this Resolution.
