

RESOLUTION 87- 21

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING THAT \$4.00 FROM EACH TRAFFIC FINE COLLECTED BY THE COUNTY COURT WHICH IS DESIGNATED FOR THE COUNTY SHALL BE TENDERED TO THE SHERIFF FOR THE SCHOOL CROSSING PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the State law formerly provided that \$4.00 collected for traffic fines were to be designated for school crossing programs, and

WHEREAS, the State law no longer provides for that designation, and

WHEREAS, the County receives monies for traffic fines which is in turn divided with the cities, and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that there is a need to fund the school crossing program, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has an on going school crossing program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. Prior to the division of traffic fine monies for the County and the City, four (\$4.00) dollars from each traffic fine collected shall be tendered to the Sheriff's department for the School Crossing Program.

2. The monies to be disbursed by the Clerk pursuant to procedures set forth by his office.
