## RESOLUTION 93 - 26

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING SMOKING IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS OWNED BY NASSAU COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature has amended Florida Statutes Section 386.202 and said Section is known as the "Florida Clean Indoor Air Act"; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the legislature is to discourage designation of any area within a government building as a smoking area, and further, to prohibit smoking in public buildings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 9th day of November, 1992, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

- 1. Smoking in County owned buildings is hereby prohibited.
- 2. A sign shall be posted at all County owned buildings and the sign shall also indicate the statutory penalty which is fines

of no more than \$100.00 for the first violation and no more than \$500.00 for such subsequent violation.
