

RESOLUTION 94 - 79

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ASSISTANCE FROM THE NASSAU COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION IN OBTAINING FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BOAT RAMP TO BE LOCATED BENEATH THE THOMAS J. SHAVE BRIDGE IN NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, there is a desperate shortage of boat ramps available for the citizens of Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has planned a boat ramp to be located under the Thomas J. Shave Bridge in Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, said boat ramp location will have deep water at all times as well as areas for parking and recreational amenities such as picnic tables; and

WHEREAS, a boat ramp at this location would provide a significant benefit for the citizens of Nassau County as well as providing a significant benefit for tourism for the entire County.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 28th day of February, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:
