RESOLUTION 95 - 125

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A MORE EQUITABLE FUNDING FORMULA FOR FEDERAL CRIME BLOCK GRANTS.

WHEREAS, the United States Senate will begin to develop a funding formula for Federal Crime Block Grants; and

WHEREAS, the United States House of Representatives has previously passed a funding formula; and

WHEREAS, the House formula disproportionately favors cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 11th day of September, 1995, that the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, hereby requests that the U.S. Senate:

- 1. Divide funds for the states by county lines based upon relative shares of serious crimes.
- 2. Use comparable criminal justice expenditure data to distribute funds to local governments.
- 3. A copy of this Resolution be provided to Senator Connie Mack and Senator Bob Graham as well as Representative Tillie Fowler and Representative Bill McCollum.
