ORDINANCE 2008 04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 87-37, KNOWN AS THE NASSAU COUNTY JAIL ORDINANCE; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 3, CHIEF CORRECTIONAL OFFICER; SECTION 4, MONETARY CONTROL; DELETING SECTION 5, SUPPLEMENTAL MONIES; DELETING SECTION 6, REPORTS; ADDING A NEW SECTION 6, SEVERABILITY; RENUMBERING AND AMENDING SECTION 7, TERMINATION; RENUMBERING SECTION 8, EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners previously adopted Ordinance 87-37 designating the Sheriff of Nassau County as the Chief Correctional Officer of the County.

WHEREAS, since the ordinance was adopted in 1987, many improvements have occurred in the county correctional system.

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments are consistent with the current policies and practices of the Board of County Commissioners and the Nassau County Sheriff's Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THIS <u>14TH</u> DAY OF APRIL 2008, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 87-37, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE

This ordinance shall be known as the "Nassau County Jail Ordinance".

SECTION 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to designate the Sheriff of Nassau County as the Chief Correctional Officer of the County Correctional System of Nassau County, and to provide for budgetary controls.

SECTION 3. CHIEF CORRECTIONAL OFFICER

1. The Sheriff of Nassau County is hereby designated the Chief Correctional Officer of the County, <u>pursuant to Section 951.06</u>, <u>Florida Statutes</u>, <u>for Nassau County</u>, <u>Florida</u>, <u>with all duties and obligations of such office</u>. and he is responsible to appoint correctional officers.

- 2. The Sheriff, as Chief Correctional Officer shall appoint correctional officers based upon the budget approved by the Board of County Commissioners. The Sheriff, as Chief Correctional Officer, shall appoint such officers and support personnel, as he deems necessary.
- 3. The Sheriff or his designated Jail Administrator shall enforce all existing State laws and Administrative Rules of the Department of Corrections concerning the operation and maintenance of County Jails.
- 4. Salaries for said correctional officers shall be paid from the general revenue fund and shall be included by the Sheriff in his proposed budget of expenditures for the maintenance and operation of the County Jail.
- 5. The Sheriff or his designated Jail Administrator shall be responsible to insure that the facility is operated in accordance with the Department of Corrections requirements and all other existing State laws and the Florida Model Jail Standards.
- 6. The Sheriff or his Jail Administrator shall be responsible to insure that any deficiencies noted by the Department of Corrections are addressed and corrected. The Board of County Commissioners shall provide for all maintenance and repairs needed at the Nassau County Detention Center.
- 7. The Sheriff shall insure that all Correctional Officers and the Jail Administrator are properly trained and certified pursuant to State Law. All individuals hired as Correctional Officers shall meet Department of Corrections requirements upon hiring unless written waivers are obtained from the Department.

SECTION 4. MONETARY CONTROL

The Sheriff of Nassau County shall, when submitting his annual budget to the Board of County Commissioners, provide a separate budgetary request, with his overall budget, for the Nassau County Detention Facility. Said budget shall include salaries for correctional officers as well as funds for the maintenance and operation of the Detention Facility. The Board of County Commissioners shall adequately fund the operation and maintenance of the Nassau County Detention Facility.

- a. The approved detention facility budget shall be utilized by the Sheriff of Nassau County for the Nassau County Detention Facility as set forth herein only and for no other purpose other than the Detention Facility.
 - b. The Sheriff of Nassau County shall submit, monthly, to the Board of County Commissioners, a statement indicating monies receipted and expended on behalf of the Nassau County Detention Facility. Said

quarterly statements shall be signed by the Sheriff and reviewed by the Board of County Commissioners at their appropriate meeting.

<u>SECTION 5. SUPPLEMENTAL MONIES</u>

The Board shall provide no additional monies except for items that pertain to the major structure of the Detention Facility (i.e. roof, support walls). Reports to the Board of County Commissioners from the Sheriff of Nassau County, in his capacity as Chief Correctional Officer, shall submit a monthly report to the Board regarding the Detention Facility and provide the Board with all copies of correspondence between the Sheriff and the Department of Corrections.

SECTION 6. - REPORTS

The Sheriff, in his capacity as Chief Correctional Officer, shall report monthly to the Board of County Commissioners regarding the Detention facility. In addition, copies of all correspondence regarding the Detention facility between the Sheriff and his Jail Administrator and the Department of Corrections or any other entity shall immediately be provided to the Board.

SECTION-75. TERMINATION

The appointment of the Sheriff as the Chief Correctional Officer may be terminated upon the vote of the County Commissioners or upon sixty (60) days written notice from the Sheriff of Nassau County to the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners relinquishing said appointment.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause, provision or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 87. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon being filed with the Secretary of State.
