

ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 23½ OF THE NASSAU COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES (ORDINANCE NO. 2014-23), SPECIFICALLY SETTING FORTH THE APPROVAL AUTHORITY FOR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS USING COUNTY FACILITIES AND BALL PARKS; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, has adopted policies and procedures in place for the utilization of county facilities by the public; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, adopted Ordinance No. 2014-23, exempting governmental agencies from the provisions for rental of county facilities and ball parks; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it necessary to amend Section 23½-83(c) to allow the Facilities Maintenance Director to waive rental fees for non-profit agencies upon submittal of the required paperwork.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Section 23½-83(c) of the Nassau County Code of Ordinances, shall be further amended to read as follows:

SECTION 23½-83 – Rental Rates for the Use of County Facilities and Ball Parks

(c) Bona-fide not for profit organizations must complete the necessary paperwork and obtain ~~County Manager~~ approval from the Facilities Maintenance Director before renting a County Facility.

SEVERABILITY.



This ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the Secretary of State.


