A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 97-185, WHICH SET FORTH RIGHT OF WAY PERMIT FEES, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 97-14.


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, adopted Resolution No. 97-185, which set forth Right of Way Permit Fees; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Services Director has recommended that the municipalities in Nassau County, Florida be exempt from the payment of the Right of Way Permit Fees if the said city or town exempts permit fees for work in the right of way within their jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this 23rd day of February, 2009 by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. The fees set forth in this Resolution shall be as set forth in the attached Fee Schedule.
2. If, the city or town within the county's jurisdiction exempts permit fees for work in its right of way, then, in that event, said town or city shall be exempt from paying the fees set forth herein.
