

ORDINANCE NO. 99-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 95-31, AS AMENDED, WHICH LEVIED A ONE (1) PERCENT SALES SURTAX, SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 3, PURPOSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, finds it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that the one (1) cent sales tax be utilized for the construction of an Emergency Operations Center or 911 Emergency Management Facility (E.O.C.) or combination E.O.C./911 emergency facility.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, this 25th day of January, 1999, that Ordinance No. 95-31 shall be further amended as follows:

1. SECTION 3. PURPOSE


The purpose of this ordinance is to levy a one (1) cent sales tax on all transactions occurring in Nassau County that are subject to state tax imposed on sales, use, services, rentals, admissions and other transactions pursuant to Florida Statutes 212.054. The revenues generated by said levy shall be utilized for: 1. operational expenses of any infrastructure; 2. the construction of a new jail facility, including architectural and engineering fees, land acquisition and any studies necessary as determined by the Board of County Commissioners; 3. renovations and additions to the existing courthouse including construction, architectural and engineering services and all studies related thereto; 4. construction of an administration facility including architectural and engineering fees, land acquisition and any other costs associated therewith as determined by the Board of County Commissioners; 5. acquisition and/or construction of temporary facilities for the housing of prisoners; 6. leasing and renovations of

temporary facilities for the Judiciary and Clerk of court; ~~and~~ 7. the payment for the housing of prisoners at a location other than the Nassau County Detention Facility, until such time as the new detention facility is operational; 8. construction of an Emergency Operations Center (E.O.C.) or 911 Emergency Management Facility or combination E.O.C./911 Emergency Facility.

2. EFFECTIVE DATE


This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed with the Secretary of State's Office.


