RESOLUTION NO. 98-04

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 96-34, AS AMENDED, WHICH ESTABLISHED PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED FROM THE ONE (1) PERCENT SALES TAX ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, ON DECEMBER 11, 1995; SPECIFICALLY PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR REPAIR OF THE REPEATER AND MICROWAVE SYSTEM FOR THE COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT HOUSED AT THE NASSAU COUNTY DETENTION FACILITY AND APPROPRIATE TOWERS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners approved the imposition of a one percent sales tax on December 11, 1995; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance approving said sales tax requires that projects to be funded with the proceeds of the one percent sales tax as identified in a Resolution to be approved at a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 97-25 authorized the expenditure of funds for operational expenses of specific infrastructure, including the Jail; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been made aware of the need to expend funds for the repair of the repeater and microwave system for the communications equipment at the Nassau County Detention Facility and the appropriate towers; and

WHEREAS, the equipment is an integral part of the Detention Facility; and

whereas, the repair of this equipment is necessary in order to ensure the proper operation of the 911 system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this 12th day of January, 1998, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

 The Board of County Commissioners authorizes the expenditure of the proceeds of the one percent sales tax for the repair of the repeater and microwave system for the communications equipment at the Nassau County Detention Facility and appropriate towers.
