

ORDINANCE NO. 71-10

NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE TAKING, POSSESSION OR SALE OF SEA TURTLES OR SEA TURTLE EGGS UPON THE SHORES OF NASSAU COUNTY; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF NASSAU COUNTY:

Section 1. Within the limits of Nassau County, no person, firm or corporation shall take, possess, sell, offer for sale, or transport sea turtles or sea turtle eggs during the months of May, June, July and August of any year.

Section 2. Any person convicted of a violation of Section 1 of this act shall be punished by fine of not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment in the county jail for not exceeding sixty (60) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its being adopted and filed with the office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee.
