

ORDINANCE NO. 71-2

NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 67-1746, LAWS OF FLORIDA, SPECIAL ACTS OF 1967 BY THE ADDITION OF SECTION 2-A TO PROVIDE FOR THE METHOD OF PAYMENT OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO MUNICIPAL AND VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF NASSAU COUNTY:

Section 1. Chapter 67-1746, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1967 is amended by the addition of Section 2-A to read as follows:

Section 2-A. The appropriations as contained in Section 1 of this Act is for a county purpose, for the protection of the citizens of Nassau County from the hazards of fire and payments from such fund shall be made directly to said municipalities and volunteer fire departments within the county upon their own requisition.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its being adopted and filed with the office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee.
