ORDINANCE NO. 73-20

NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 9-1, ORDINANCE OF NASSAU COUNTY, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSION TO RAISE THE \$33,000.00 BUDGET LIMIT TO \$50,000.00 FOR AIDING AND ASSISTING VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN NASSAU COUNTY AND RE-IMBURSING MUNICIPALITIES IN NASSAU COUNTY FOR FIRE CALLS MADE BY MUNICIPAL FIRE DEPARTMENTS OUTSIDE THEIR MUNICIPALITIES, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF NASSAU COUNTY:

Section 1. Chapter 9, Section 9-1, Ordinance of Nassau County, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County is authorized to include in its annual budget an item not to exceed an amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), for the purpose of aiding and assisting volunteer fire departments in said county and reimbursing municipalities within Nassau County for fire calls made by municipal fire departments outside of their municipal limits.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its being adopted and filed with the office of the Secretary of State in Tallahassee.
