

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN ACT DEALING WITH THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON THAT CERTAIN ROAD IN NASSAU COUNTY KNOWN AS THE AMELIA ISLAND PARKWAY.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, is authorized to set speed zones upon County Roads under Section 317.233(2), Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, this Board, after full and careful investigation and in conformity to criteria promulgated by the State Road Department, has determined that in the best interest of public safety and welfare, the maximum limit on that certain road in Nassau County known as The Amelia Island Parkway shall be 35 miles per hour, and that clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits be posted in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zone.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular meeting duly assembled, that the maximum speed limit on that certain road in Nassau County known as The Amelia Island Parkway shall be 35 miles per hour, and that the County Engineer is hereby directed to obtain clearly legible signs showing such maximum speed limits and to post such signs in appropriate areas along said road to adequately inform the public of said speed zone.
