## AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 74-33

, 1974, the Board of WHEREAS, on the 8th day of October County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida did adopt ORDINANCE NO. 74-33, an Ordinance enacting and establishing a comprehensive

zoning code for the unincorporated portion of Nassau County, Florida;

and

the owner of the real WHEREAS, MAY ELLEN COOK, property described in this ordinance, has applied to the Board of County Commissioners for a rezoning and reclassification of that Commercial Intensive Residential Mixed to property from and

WHEREAS, the NASSAU COUNTY ZONING BOARD, after due notice and public hearing, has made its recommendations to the commission; and

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the above recommendations, the commission finds that such rezoning is consistent with the overall comprehensive zoning ordinance and orderly development of the County of Nassau, Florida;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County sioners of Nassau County, Florida:

Section 1: Property Rezoned-The real property described in Residential Mixed Section 2 is rezoned and reclassified from Commercial Intense as defined and classified under to the Zoning Ordinance, Nassau County, Florida.
