

ORDINANCE NO. 75-45

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(a) of ORDINANCE 74-34 PROVIDING THAT THE APPLICATION FOR AND PURCHASE OF LICENSES AND THE PAYMENT OF FEES SHALL BE FROM THOSE AREAS AS DESIGNATED BY THE ANIMAL CONTROL AUTHORITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY, THAT:

Section 3. LICENSING

(a) No person shall own, keep or harbor any dog within the County unless such dog is licensed as herein provided. Written application for and purchase of such license shall be made to the agents of the Animal Control Authority as shall be designated by the Animal Control Authority or the County Tax Collector, and shall state the name and address of the owner and the name, breed, color, age and sex of the dog, as well as proof of inoculation against rabies if the animal is old enough to receive said shots. The license fee shall be paid in those areas as designated by the Animal Control Authority and be paid at the time of making application. A numbered receipt shall be given to the applicant, and a numbered metallic tag shall be issued to the owner.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon enactment, and become law.
