ORDINANCE NO. 78-2 NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSE TO CARRY A PISTOL. PROVIDING FOR THE AGE AND CHARACTER OF THE LICENSE HOLDER. PROVIDING FOR A PERIOD OF LICENSE EXPIRATION. PROVIDING FOR A BOND. PROVIDING FOR RECORDS TO BE KEPT. PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 790.06, allows for the County Commission of the respective counties of this State to issue licenses for certain weapons,

SECTION 1: The BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF NASSAU COUNTY may at any regular or special meeting grant a license to carry certain weapons.

SECTION 2: Those weapons which are allowed to be carried under this Ordinance shall be restricted to pistols.

SECTION 3: Only those persons which are of 18 years of age or older and of good moral character may be licensed. Such character being attested to by the written statement of three (3) persons, one of which is the County Judge, County Sheriff and the minister of a church and congregation of Nassau County.

SECTION 4: Period of time for this license to endure shall be two (2) years from the date of this issuance.

SECTION 5: The applicants must give a bond payable to the Governor of the State of Florida in the sum of \$100.00, conditioned for the proper and legitimate use of said weapons, with sureties to be approved by the County Commissioners.

SECTION 6: The Commissioners shall keep a record of the names of the persons taking out such a license, the name of the maker of the pistol so licensed to be carried, and the caliber and number of the same.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be effective upon becoming law.
