ORDINANCE NO. 81- 8

THIS IS AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-3 OF THE CODE OF LAWS AND ORDINANCES, COUNTY OF NASSAU, FLORIDA, AMENDING SPECIAL ACTS, CHAPTER 67-1740, §1; ORDINANCE NO. 73-27, 10-23-73, RAISING THE BID LIMIT FROM TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) TO THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$<sup>3</sup>,000.00), PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, because of rising costs of all facets of County government, finds it necessary to raise the bid limit from \$2,000.00 to \$3,000.00, and

WHEREAS, it is within their authority to raise the bid limitation from \$2,000.00 to \$3,000.00,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following Ordinance is hereby enacted.

## SECTION 1-3. MAXIMUM PURCHASES WITHOUT BIDS.

The Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County is authorized to enter into contracts and purchase goods, supplies and materials when such contracts or purchases three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) are in amounts of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) or less without advertising for or taking bids under section 128.108, Florida Statutes (Sp.Acts, Ch.67-1740,§1; Ord.No.73-27, 10-23-73)

This Ordinance shall be effective upon becoming law. DONE and ADOPTED in regular session this <u>24th</u> day of <u>March</u>, 1981.
