ORDINANCE NO. 83-3

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 74-33

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of October, 1974, the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida, did adopt ORDINANCE NO. 74-33, an Ordinance enacting and establishing a comprehensive zoning code for the unincorporated portion of Nassau County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. L. R. Church (L. R. Church Estate) the owner(s) of the real property described in this ordinance, has applied to the Board of County Commissioners for a rezoning and reclassification of that property from Open Rural (OR) to Commercial Intensive (CI) ; and,

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Zoning Board, after due notice and public hearing has made its recommendations to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the above recom-mendations, the Commission finds that such rezoning is consistent with the overall comprehensive zoning ordinance and orderly development of the County of Nassau, Florida;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida:

SECTION 1: Property Rezoned: The real property described in Section 2 is rezoned and reclassified from Open Rural (OR) to Commercial Intensive (CI) as defined and classified under the Zoning Ordinance, Nassau County, Florida.

SECTION 2: Owner and Description: The land rezoned by this ordinance is owned by Mrs. L. R. Church (L. R. Church Estate) and is described as follows:

SECTION 3: Effective Date: This ordinance shall become effective upon being signed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida.

A PORTICN OF SECTION 40, TOUNCHIE 2 NORTH, RADIE 28 EAST, NARLAU COUNTY, FLORIDA.

Being a portion of the lands described in deed recorded in the Public records of said County, in Deed Book 97, Page 25.

Said portion being more particularly described as follows: For a point of reference commence at a point where the Westerly line of Section 40 aforementioned is intersected by the Northerly right-of-way line of State Road No. 200 (said right-of-way lies 60.0' Feet Northerly and parallel to the survey line of said Road); and run South 72° -55' East along said right-of-way a distance of 507.06 Feet To the POINT OF BEGINNING.
