ORDINANCE NO. 89-13 AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 83-19 NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, on the 28th day of September, 1983, the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida, did adopt Ordinance No. 83-19, an Ordinance enacting and establishing a comprehensive zoning code for the unincorporated portion of Nassau County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, MR. and MRS. DONALD W. ANDERSON, MIKE CLOWER, Agent, owners of the real property described in this Ordinance, has applied to the Board of County Commissioners for a rezoning and reclassification of the property from RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY - 2 (RS-2) to COMMERCIAL INTENSIVE (CI).

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Zoning Board, after due notice and public hearing has made its recommendations to the Commission; and

consideration WHEREAS, taking into recommendations, the Commission finds that such rezoning is consistent with the overall comprehensive zoning ordinance and orderly development of the County of Nassau, Florida, and the specific area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida:

SECTION 1: PROPERTY REZONED: The real property described in Section 2 is rezoned and reclassified from RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY - 2 (RS-2) to COMMERCIAL INTENSIVE (CI), as defined and classified under the zoning Ordinance, Nassau County, Florida.

SECTION 2: OWNER AND DESCRIPTION: The land rezoned by this ordinance is owned by MR. and MRS. DONALD W. ANDERSON, MIKE CLOWER, Agent, and is described as follows:
