ORDINANCE NO. 90 ·· 04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 81-6, AS AMENDED, WHICH ESTABLISHED EMERGENCY FEES AND NON-EMERGENCY RESCUE FEES FOR CALLS MADE WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF NASSAU COUNTY; SAID AMENDMENT INCREASES THE FEES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has received testimony that the charges for emergency and non-emergency rescue services need to be increased, and;

WHEREAS, the fees charged by surrounding counties are higher than Nassau County, and;

WHEREAS, the increase in fees is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County in order to continue to provide the current services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 23rd day of January , 1990, that Ordinance No. 81-6 be amended as follows:

1. SECTION 1. EMERGENCY RATES

Emergency rescue service shall be provided for all citizens of Nassau County, Florida, based upon the following rates:
