

ORDINANCE 94 - 45

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 81-28, AS AMENDED, WHICH ESTABLISHED MINIMUM STANDARDS GOVERNING PLUMBING INSTALLATION, INCLUDING ALTERATIONS, REPAIRS, REPLACEMENT, EQUIPMENT, APPLIANCES, FIXTURES, FITTINGS, AND/OR APPURTENANCES THERETO; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING SECTION 1. TO ADOPT THE 1994 EDITION OF THE SOUTHERN PLUMBING CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has found it is in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that the current edition of the Southern Standard Plumbing Code be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 26th day of September, 1994, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 81-28, as amended, be further amended as follows:

1. SECTION 1. SOUTHERN STANDARD PLUMBING CODE: The Southern Standard Plumbing Code, being particularly the ~~1991~~ 1994 edition, as promulgated by the Southern Building Code Congress International, as adopted, thereof and the whole thereof, save and except such portions as may hereinafter be amended, and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set forth at length herein, and from the date on which this order shall take effect, the provisions therein shall be controlling the plumbing installation, including alterations, repairs, replacement, equipment, appliances, fixtures, fittings and/or appurtenances thereto, and/or, when connected to the water or sewage system.

2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its filing with


the Office of the Secretary of State.


