

ORDINANCE 95 - 14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 83-19, AS AMENDED, WHICH ESTABLISHED A COMPREHENSIVE ZONING CODE AND ZONING MAPS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED PORTIONS OF NASSAU COUNTY; SPECIFICALLY AMENDING ARTICLE 32, DISTANCE RESTRICTIONS OF VENDORS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FROM CHURCHES AND SCHOOLS, BY PROHIBITING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND INTOXICATING BEVERAGES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners previously amended Ordinance 83-19, as amended, to include Article 32 dealing with the sale of intoxicating beverages within one thousand airline feet (1,000') of a church or school; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has become aware that, due to State statutory and regulatory changes, alcoholic beverages need to be prohibited in the same manner as intoxicating beverages.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 24th day of July, 1995, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 83-19, as amended, be further amended as follows:

I. ARTICLE 32: DISTANCE RESTRICTIONS OF VENDORS OF ALCOHOLIC OR INTOXICATING BEVERAGES FROM CHURCHES AND SCHOOLS


A. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to establish, maintain or carry on the business of vendor of alcoholic or intoxicating beverages within one thousand (1,000) feet in airline distance measured from building to building at their closest points to any established school or church; provided that nothing herein contained shall affect any such business, vending alcoholic or intoxicating beverages both for sale

for consumption on or off the premises, which was actually being legally carried on within such distance of any established school or church at the time of the passage of this ordinance.

B. Section 5.03 - Conditional Use and Section 5.05 - Variance shall not apply to this Article.


II. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its being filed in the office of the Secretary of State.
