

**ORDINANCE NO. 96- 08**  
**AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 83-19**  
**NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of September, 1983, the Board of County Commissioners, Nassau County, Florida, did adopt Ordinance No. 83-19, an Ordinance enacting and establishing a comprehensive zoning code for the unincorporated portion of Nassau County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, James J. Cravey and Brenda C. Cravey, the owners of the real property described in this Ordinance has applied to the Board of County Commissioners for a rezoning and reclassification of the property from COMMERCIAL NEIGHBORHOOD (CN) to OPEN RURAL (OR); and

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Zoning Board, after due notice and public hearing has made its recommendations to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the above recommendations, the Commission finds that such rezoning is consistent with the overall comprehensive land use plan and orderly development of the County of Nassau, Florida, and the specific area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida:

SECTION 1: PROPERTY REZONED: The real property described in Section 2 is rezoned and reclassified from COMMERCIAL NEIGHBORHOOD (CN) to OPEN RURAL (OR) as defined and classified under the zoning Ordinance, Nassau County, Florida.

SECTION 2: OWNER AND DESCRIPTION: The land rezoned by this ordinance is owned by James J. Cravey and Brenda C. Cravey, and is described as follows:

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective upon being signed by the Chairman of the Board of

County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida.



## MAP SHOWING SURVEY OF

A part of Section 3, Township 1 North, Range 25 East, Nassau County, Florida, being more particularly described as commencing at a concrete monument at the Northwest corner of Lot 2, Block 1, Nassau Plantations (unrecorded); thence South  $89^{\circ}57'11''$  West, along a Westerly prolongation of the Northerly boundary of said Lot 2, Block 1, a distance of 88.68 feet; thence North  $4^{\circ}57'10''$  West, 66.71 feet to the Northerly right of way line of Church Road; thence South  $89^{\circ}12'$  West, along said right of way line, 375.0 feet to a point for the point of beginning; thence continue South  $89^{\circ}12'$  West, along said right of way line, 251.50 feet; thence North  $0^{\circ}45'10''$  East, 414.00 feet; thence North  $89^{\circ}12'00''$  East, 291.50 feet; thence South  $6^{\circ}15'20''$  West, 417.01 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 2.58 acres more or less.
