

ORDINANCE 2001 - 37

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PARKING RESTRICTIONS AT THE TEMPORARY COURTHOUSE; PROVIDING FOR A REMEDY FOR VIOLATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Judiciary has requested that the Board of County Commissioners impose parking restrictions at the Temporary Courthouse facility; and

WHEREAS, the parking restrictions are necessary for the orderly control of reserved parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners conducted a public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 15th day of October, 2001, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, as follows:

1. TITLE: This Ordinance shall be known as the "Temporary Courthouse Parking Ordinance".

2. PURPOSE: The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide for the orderly control of the reserved parking spaces at the Temporary Courthouse.

3. RESTRICTIONS: At the Temporary Courthouse parking areas, no person shall park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, in a parking area marked "Reserved Official Use Only", without prior written authorization by the Administrative Judge of Nassau County, and a copy of

said authorization provided to the Chief Bailiff at the Temporary Courthouse.

4. REMEDY:

a. Any law enforcement officer, upon finding a vehicle without proper authorization parked in a reserved space, may have the vehicle towed.

b. The vehicle may be towed by a designated towing company, and the costs of said towing, as well as any impoundment fees, shall be paid by the registered owner of the towed vehicle.

5. SIGNAGE: Parking spaces having signs stating "Reserved Official Use Only" shall be designated by the Sheriff or his designee and shall be marked, by the County, with green lettering "Reserved Official Use Only" signs. Additional signage shall be posted by the County indicating that vehicles will be towed and costs and fines imposed.


6. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its being received by the Office of the Secretary of State.


