

ORDINANCE 2003 - 43

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 90-19, AS AMENDED, IN ITS ENTIRETY, WHICH REGULATED ATLANTIC BEACH AND NASSAU SOUND BEACH CONCESSIONS ON NASSAU COUNTY BEACHES WITHIN THE AREAS UNDER NASSAU COUNTY'S CONTROL ON AMELIA ISLAND; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners had found it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Nassau County that Ordinance 90-19, as amended, be rescinded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 11<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2003, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, that Ordinance 90-19, as amended, is hereby rescinded.

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance is enacted on August 11, 2003, upon the affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of County Commissioners and shall become effective on October 1, 2003. All licenses currently issued by the County shall remain in effect until the end of the license term.


