

ORDINANCE 2003 - 58

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 2003-33, WHICH AMENDED THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF NASSAU COUNTY, ORDINANCE 91-04, AS AMENDED, PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATION ACT (CHAPTER 163, PART II, FLORIDA STATUTES); SPECIFICALLY RECLASSIFYING PROPERTY FROM CONSERVATION-WETLANDS TO LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL ON THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County has found it necessary to rescind Ordinance 2003-33; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Affairs has rejected the previously approved Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED this 24th day of November, 2003, by the Board of County Commissioners of Nassau County, Florida, hereby rescinds Ordinance 2003-33, in its entirety, effective as follows:
